Responds to the prompt (1.0)	Entry fully addresses what is asked in the assignment.	Entry partially addresses what is asked in the assignment.	Entry minimally addresses what is asked in the assignment.
Critical and integrative thinking (1.0)	Entry demonstrates thoughtful engagement with the questions and makes connections to experiences or insights from the student's life.	Entry demonstrates cursory engagement with the questions and makes minimal connections to experiences or insights from the student's life.	Entry does not engage the questions or make connections to experiences or insights from the student's life.
Writing quality (1.0)	Language is clear and writing is well organized. Uses proper grammar and sentence structure.	Language communicates but could be clearer and better organized. Includes a few grammatical errors.	Writing is difficult to understand and poorly organized. Includes consistent grammatical errors.
Timeliness / Length requirements (1.0)	Entry is submitted on time and meets the required minimum word count of 300 words, including any required photographs, audio recordings, or other data.	Entry is submitted more than 12 hours late or is between 250 and 300 words in length and/or does not include all required photographs, audio recordings, or other data.	Entry is submitted more than 24 hours late or is less than 250 words in length and/or does not include any required photographs, audio recordings, or other data.
